## About the Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN) Program

The student will learn basic concepts in pharmacology, nutrition, psychology, anatomy, physiology, medical-surgical nursing, care of mother and her newborn, normal growth and development, concepts of leadership for healthcare in the classroom and clinical settings. Integrated throughout the program are Academic and CTE standards, which include safety, communication, technology, ethics, career planning, and other employment skills. Clinical worksite learning is a required component of the program.

## What jobs does this program prepare me for?

The Vocational Nursing Program is designed to prepare students for state licensure as a Vocational Nurse in California. The Vocational Nurse Program addresses skills necessary for student success in medical disciplines and careers.
