## About the Health Support Occupations (HSO) Program.

This program prepares participants for entry-level jobs that provide assistance to healthcare professionals in completing their tasks. Participants benefit from a balanced blend of classroom and supervised clinical site training at local hospitals, clinics and related medical offices. In addition, all trainees receive job readiness training and introductory computer skills instruction. Students are in the classroom for the first 4- 5 weeks then receive the opportunity to train at a clinical site for job experience.
