About the Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA)

CNAs ensure the wellbeing of their patients by performing a variety of tasks that help with daily living activities such as feeding, bathing, dressing and other various hygiene practices. The CNA checks and monitors patient vital signs, safely turns and moves patients, and follows individualized patient care plans. CNAs typically spend more time with patients than nurses or doctors, they understand patient behaviors and health statuses.

- Lift, bend, stoop, walk, stand as necessary for job duties
- Up-to-date immunizations required by clinical sites (including MMR, HEP B TDAP, Varicella, Flu, Covid-19)
